SMALL QUILT SILENT AUCTION

A Small Quilt Auction will be part of our October Harvest Gold Quilt Show. Each member is encouraged to contribute a quilt. The auction quilts will be made and/or quilted by members and donated to the Guild. The proceeds will help to fund our guild's classes and other activities for the next two years.

GUIDELINES FOR YOUR AUCTION QUILT

- 1. Quilts should be no larger than 100" total outside dimensions height plus width, times 2. They can be any shape that does not exceed this size.
- 2. Techniques can include piecing, applique', embroidery, whole cloth, or combinations.
- 3. Hand quilt, machine quilt, and/or embellish your quilt.
- 4. Sign and date your quilt on the bottom right-hand corner on the back. Sleeves are optional.
- 5. Quilts are to be turned in to a coordinator by the September business meeting. Each quilt should be accompanied by a completed data sheet, which will be used to prepare the catalog of auction quilts. The data sheet will be given to the high bidder along with the quilt. Pin the data sheet to the top of the quilt so we'll know which side is up we don't want to hang quilts upside-down or sideways!

This will be a silent auction with bidding starting when the quilt show opens and closing two hours before the show ends. Minimum initial bid will be \$20 for each quilt. If the minimum bid is not met, the quilt may be bought back by the quiltmaker for \$10, may be purchased for the low bid price, or will be donated in the name of the guild to a local organization providing community services.
